
THE BALTIC STATES

ESTONIA, LATVIA and LITHUANIA

1919-1939



The three small states Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania lay on the south eastern coast of the Baltic Sea bordered by Russia to the north east and Poland to the south west. Due to their geographic position they are collectively known as the Baltic States. The region is peopled by the Estonians and North Livonians who are of Finnish stock while the people of Courland and Lithuania are Letts and are of Indo-European stock.

During the last seven centuries the Estonians and Letts formed the majority of the population of the Baltic regions and were subjugated and converted to Christianity from 1330 onwards by the Knights of the Teutonic Order, the native peasants becoming the virtual slaves of their German masters. Even when the Teutonic Order was dissolved in 1561 the Germans remained the ruling class. Early in the eighteenth century the area was conquered by Russia and in 1801 a new era began under Tsar Alexander I, Russian nationals appearing in large numbers beside the German masters and the Estonian and Lettish serfs. Progress in not usually associated with the rule of the Tsars but at that time it brought to the area peasant emancipation, agricultural reform, education and some urban expansion.

The region remained a part of Imperial Russia until late 1917 when it was annexed by Germany and under the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk, signed on March 3 1918, the territories were formally given over to Germany by the new Bolshevik government which had taken power in Russia in 1917. However, after the signing of the Armistice on the 11th of November 1918 and the cessation of hostilities with Germany, Estonia and Latvia emerged as independent republics, Estonia taking Northern Livonia and Latvia taking Courland and Southern Livonia, thus effecting a division according to the races. Lithuania had declared itself independent in February 1918 and was recognised as such by all the great powers, including Germany.

After becoming independent the three new states made considerable progress, largely with the aid of British capital and with the British market as the principal recipient of their products. Agriculture and dairy farming were the basic industries, small holdings being the general rule, but much of the area is heavily forested so forestry, woodworking and the production of other wood based products gives employment to many. The region is also important in that it contains some of the chief ports on the Baltic Sea, Riga, Tallinn and Liepaja in particular which give access to the Russian interior.

The Baltic States enjoyed independence for a period of twentyone years. In 1940 they were drawn into the Soviet Union as
constituent republics and in 1941 they were occupied by Hitler's
armies when the German offensive was switched to the Eastern Front.
They remained under German occupation until 1944 wher they were
liberated by the armies of the Soviet Union and became Soviet
Socialist Republics within the Union which they remain to this day.

According to the 1921 census Estonia had an area of 17,953 square miles and a population of 1,109,500. The capital, Tallinn, otherwise known as Reval, was formerly a great Russian naval base. Flax was one of Estonia's main products and between 1919 and 1939 the state was prolific in its export of matches, the first consignment being in 1919 and consisting of 2,618,000 boxes. Of the three states Estonia was by far the largest exporter of matches, the Estonian match industry once consisting of a number of small companies which, in 1928, amalgamated to form Eesti Tulitikumonopol under the control of Svenska Tändsticks A.B.

The earliest known Estonian manufacturer was G.Eggens who had a factory in Tallinn from 1838 to 1848 but no evidence of his labels exists today. There are a number of other factories which fall into this category, most notable being Mohrenschildt of Kärbla (1844-1848), Erdmann & Elfenbein of Tallinn (1860-1865), Catherinehof of Narva (1860-?) and G.Lohberg of Tallinn (1863-1865). Any labels from these concerns, if any actually exist, must be considered very rare indeed.

F.Hindreus operated in Tallinn from 1863 to 1918 but only four labels remain as proof of his existence, these being written either in Russian or in German. G.Beljagin of Tallinn (1918-1919) issued only one label which is so similar to one of Hindreus's brands that it can only be assumed that it was Beljagin who took over Hindreus in 1918. Beljagin, however, was short lived and was later taken over by Timps & Ers (1920-1923) and who issued three known labels including a household size. Timps & Ers were in turn taken over by Julius Trumm, also of Tallinn in 1923 and were in business under their own name until 1928, producing six labels including one for export which was based on the "bear" trade mark of Timps & Ers (B.005).

Tallinna Tulitikuvabrik of Tallinn operated under the control of the Eesti Tulitikumonopol from 1928 to 1933 but issued no proven export labels, only three home market labels are known and are often to be found in collections from this period. This concern was most likely preceded by Eesti Tikutoostus "Lendra" whose factory was in Tallinn and who issued many export labels between 1924 and 1928. Many of these brands were registered as trade marks both in Estonia and the United Kingdom. Notable among these are The Estomat and The Topper which are also to be found in many collections from this period. Lendra's other brands include The Building, EFA, Lendra, The Mermaid, Nelson, The Pearl of Palestine, The President, The Serpent, Sign, Three Aspes and The Troika. Lendra also registered a number of marks in the United Kingdom which, so far as is known, were never issued. These are Avenue, The Clown, Cockscomb, The Fate, Home Match, Mulberry, Pierrot-Pierrette, The Pineapple, Three Kings, Three Princes, Three Queens and Trubador. If any of these brands actually exist they must be considered as very rare. Lendra was also responsible for several home market brands, often under their own name, but most interesting is the multiplicity of home market advertising labels of which over fifty have so far been located.

Eduard Pohl who had a factory in Viljandi from 1904 to 1928 produced several labels for the home market including an interesting set of eight labels depicting farm implements for W.Schneider of Tallinn. Pohl was also heavily involved with the export market and registered a number of brands both in Estonia and the United Kingdom, the former often being under the name "Phönix" which was the name given to many of Pohl's home market labels. Of the many export labels issued by Pohl probably the most familiar are Helios and Light Ho, but he was also responsible for many lesser known brands such as A.l., The Epoch, EPV, Flare, The Liner, Mogul, The North Country, P, Ronk, Spade Brand, Sphynx, Splendid and Trump Brand. So similar in design to The Epoch and The North Country is The Matchless that this also has to attributed to Pohl. Among the many home market labels to be found after the formation of the monopoly will be found the name Viljandi Tulitikuvabrik, this is the name given to Pohl's factory at that time. This name is to be seen, on only one export label, Tulitikud, which is simply a home market label with the word "export" handstamped across it. Viljandi also issued a nice set of twenty home market labels in 1938 depicting costumes of the region and the name is still to be found today on some modern skillets which indicates that the factory is still in operation but producing matches for the home market only.

E.Schwarz had a factory in Pärnu from 1905 to 1918 but issued only two home market labels. He was succeeded by Paul Eiche of Pärnu who were in business from 1918 to 1928 and made a number of brands for export, none of which were ever registered in the United Kingdom by Eiche. In fact Eiche registered only one brand in Estonia which was, curiously enough, Marspen which was marketed in the United Kingdom by Marks and Spencer. It is thought that Eiche was the supplier of many brands imported into the United Kingdom by Joseph Franses, in fact two of Franses' brands, Caddy and Wig, are to be found with the overprint "Paul Eiche, Pärnu", these were presumably for the home market and are quite rare. Also to be considered is The Regular, this was originally marketed in the United Kingdom by Alfred Dehez, the label depicting a matchstick man. When Franses took over the brand the design was changed to the familiar "medals" which is a direct copy of one of Eiche's home market brands entitled Elektrika.

Between 1912 and 1928 Baltika of Paide were in business and were later known within the monopoly as Paide Tulitikuvabrik from 1928 to 1929 when it appears that they ceased to trade. This company issued several home market labels, but only three proven ones for export, namely The Baltic, Baltica and The Glory. It has been suggested that this factory was responsible for several of the labels exported into Denmark for advertising purposes, such as Crabbie Whisky and Kronos Cigaret. The trade mark of this company was a form of trident which appears on most of their non advertising labels, export or home market alike.

The Letts have been indigenous in the region of Latvia for over two thousand years and the republic, according to the 1921 census, had a population of 1,503,200 in an area of 24,440 square miles. Riga, the capital, once being the oldest and wealthiest trading centre on the Baltic Sea. Latvia was famous for its dairy farms and live stock but i also exported matches on a large scale.

There is little information available on the Latvian match industry but it seems that the largest concern was Latvijas Serkocinu Fabriku Aciju Saaberdriba "Vulkan" who registered four brands in the United Kingdom under their own name, only Leo Matches, The Hesperos and Irena Matches actually being issued. The fourth, Don Quixote was registered but never actually put on sale. Vulkan also manufactured matches for British importers, notable among these is Blocklight, The Casket and Woodman. Vulkan had their head office in Liepaja (Libau) and factories in Liepaja, Riga and Kuldiga (Goldingen). The company began in Kuldiga in 1878 and was operated by the Hirschmann Group, Louis Hirschmann having established a factory in Liepaja as early as 1847. There are a number of labels exported by this company before 1919, all of which are enscribed "Made in Russia". Around 1926 the Vulkan company was taken over by V.A.Lapschin, a Russian manufacturer who had started a factory in Novgorod in 1876 and the name "W.A.Lapsin" may be seen on the reverse side of some of the variations of Blocklight and Woodman. There were also a number of home market labels issued by Vulkan which, almost invariably, depict a stag in the design. The stag was Vulkan's trade mark which was registered in Estonia in 1925.

Svenska Tändsticks A.B. had an interest in one Latvian factory, Rigaer Holzdraht Fabrikations und Holzverelungs A.G., a photograph of which appears at the beginning of this book. It is thought that this factory was responsible for the Latvian varieties of a number of old Swedish labels such as Apollo, The Iceberg, Parachute and The Windmill.

Keller and Company of Riga registered the brand Komet in Estonia in 1923 and the label was issued in several variations for the home market and one for export which was simply the home market design with additional words in English. By 1929 the company had become known as Zündholzfabrik "Komet" A.G. and had exported only one other known brand which was Lustrine and was for Eric Burn of the U.K.

There was also a small factory in Sabile known as Sabiles Serkocinu Fabriku "Stars" Aciju Saaberdriba. This factory produced a number of home market labels but only two for export, namely The Latis and Stars. In 1925 I.L.Bermans established a factory in Riga which was known as "Vesuv". This factory is known to have issued at least two home market labels, one depicting a man on horseback and the other a lizard. The latter also appears as an export brand, The Salamandre.

The Latvian match industry was formed into a monopoly at some time between 1930 and 1939 and, in common with other monopolies it is virtually impossible to determine which factory produced which label after the monopoly was formed. Latvia still produces matches for the home market but it is now a State run concern operating under the name Liepajas Serkocinu Fabriku and is controlled by the Latvian State Match Control (Latfanspichkprom). It consists of the "Vesuv" factory in Riga, the "Komet" factory, also in Riga and the "Baltija" factory in Liepaja.

Unlike the two other republics Lithuania was a Grand Duchy as early as the thirteenth century and it was a Kingdom in 1252, being mentioned by the English poet Chaucer who described it as Leetuwe. In 1386 the Lithuanian sovereign became King of Poland and made his country into a powerful state. In the eighteenth century Lithuania shared the fate of Poland and was partitioned between Russia and Prussia. Vilna, the capital before 1919, was annexed to Poland after the First World War and from 1919 to 1939 the capital was Kaunas. Today it is again Vilna. In 1921 the state had an area of 23,000 square miles and a population of 2,100,000. Lithuania was at one time known as the granary of the Baltic and it also produced much of the world's flax. The area possesses vast forests but the Lithuanian match industry was not at all prominent, very few labels being known which were for export.

Compared with Estonia and Latvia much less is known of the match industry in Lithuania. In 1930 there were six factories operating in the area; Uran of Jonava, Balkan, Elektra, Etna, Tilken and Lietuvos Degtuku Akcini Bendrove, all of Kaunas. The earliest known date of a match factory in this state is 1868 which is printed on the rear panel of a variety of Etna. This brand was still being produced as late as 1930 by Degtuku Fabriku "Etna", a factory run by Finkelstein Brothers. It would appear that the labels illustrated were the only ones to be produced for export by this factory, and are very rare. The Balkan factory was operated by M.Volperto and issued two export labels entitled Balkan after the name of the factory. These are also very rare. Lietuvos Degtuku Akcini Bendrove, otherwise known as the Lithuanian Match Company, was run under the control of Svenska Tändsticks A.B. and it is probable that this factory was responsible for the more common Lithuanian export labels such as Cue and King Cole. It would appear that Uran, Tilken and Elektra produced labels for the home market only, there is no evidence of any export labels. There is one factory which has not so far been mentioned, the Baltija factory in Kaunas who issued Lietuva in two varieties for export. No dates are known for this factory but it would appear to have closed before 1930.

No brands other than those mentioned were ever exported from Lithuania and it would appear that at some time between 1930 and 1939 the industry was formed into a monopoly, labels which were issued by the monopoly being for the home market and enscribed "Lietuvos Monopolio". No Lithuanian company ever registered a trade mark for matches in the United Kingdom. However, the Lithuanian match industry is still active today in the home market having issued a set of labels in 1978, the set consists of 40 labels which depict sports of all kinds and are enscribed "Liepsna Kaunas".

During the period when the Baltic States were independent they exported matches on a very large scale, Estonia and Latvia in particular. The last export would have been in 1939 before the outbreak of the Second World War. Most of the matches exported were destined for the United Kingdom or the United States, while a smaller number were for other countries such as Denmark. Because of the short period during which matches were imported from these states the labels are now very collectable and sometimes difficult to obtain, but not impossible as they often appear in old collections of the period and those which are most common are those which were exported in large quantities. It will be noted that in a number of cases brands issued by the Baltic States have also been issued by other countries such as Sweden, Austria, Finland, Russia, Poland, Czechoslovakia and Belgium. These are, of course, customers' own brands but it does mean that many Baltic labels have "cousins" from other parts of Europe. In some cases the date of registration is before 1919, this merely means that the mark was registered on the date stated but the Baltic version did not appear until later.

According to "Deutsche Zündwaren-Zietung", the magazine of the German matchmakers society, in issue 3 dated March 1926 the Estonian match industry was tabulated as follows:

In the same issue of the magazine was also a list of Latvian factories concerned with the making of matches and match splints. Those concerned only with the production of matches are detailed below.

In an issue of the same magazine dated August 1920 is the following statement: "Early in 1920 French industrial firms tried without success to manage the building of a match monopoly in Latvia when they sought close touch with the Latvian government. At this time there were six match factories in operation which produced about 1,000,000 boxes of which about 75% were exported to England".

It is the intention of this catalogue to list, illustrate and describe as fully as possible all the labels which are known to exist, it aims to be comprehensive but not exhaustive, there may be other labels which have not been included and the information on the match industries in the Baltic States is by no means complete due to the lack of data available and is open to criticism. In all cases the name of the country is as written on the label, i.e. Estonia, Esthonia, Estland, Latvia, Latvija, Latwija. On some labels the country of origin is not shown and it is then stated in parenthesis, for example (Estonia).


